



Falmouth Girls Hockey Club 2008 Scholarship Program Guidelines

GENERAL INFORMATION:

The Falmouth Girls Hockey Club "PRIDE" is a non-profit organization that offers a program to girls to play the game of ice hockey with girls of similar age and ability in other communities and leagues. The Falmouth Girls Hockey Club is incorporated as a Massachusetts non-profit corporation. Falmouth Girls Hockey Club, Inc.

The Club promotes good sportswomanship and requires this among the girls involved and encourages the players to do their best, whether it is on the ice, in schoolwork, with peers, in their community or in their country. The Club promotes PRIDE as a life long learning experience.

MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY:

- Skater must be a past or present member of the Falmouth Girls Hockey Club
- The scholarship is open to only past and present Pride Players. Each player must have been a member for at least 2 years; with some flexibility being allowed on the 2-year minimum, at the discretion of the Board.
- The skater must be accepted at a post-secondary school.
- Checks will be made out directly to the recipient at the end of September. Prior to distribution the Club must receive proof of attendance/acceptance at a post secondary school. The 2008 minimum scholarship will be \$200.00; final amount will be determined in the financial wherewithal of the Club.
- If recipient does not pursue higher education, the scholarship money will be re-deposited back into the Club's scholarship fund.
